

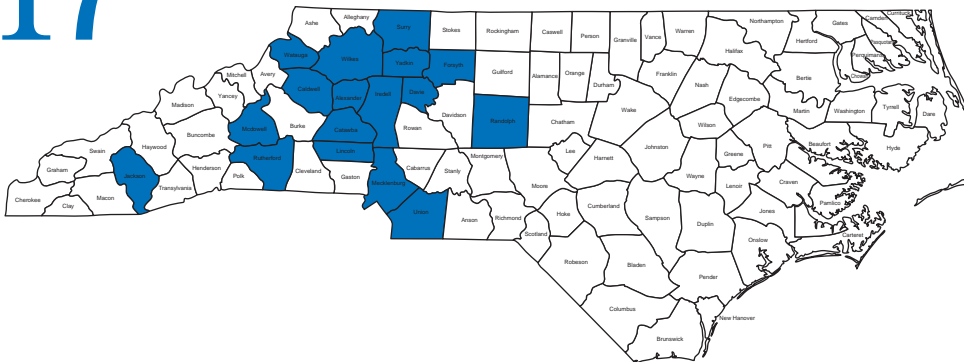

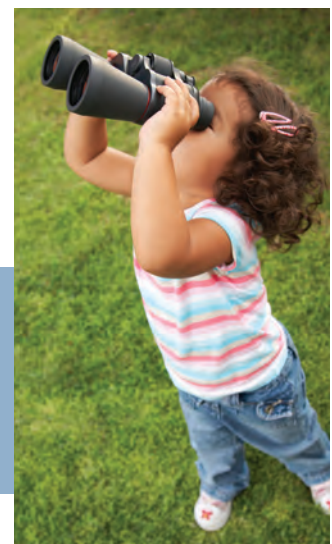

- Foster parents needing coaching and support

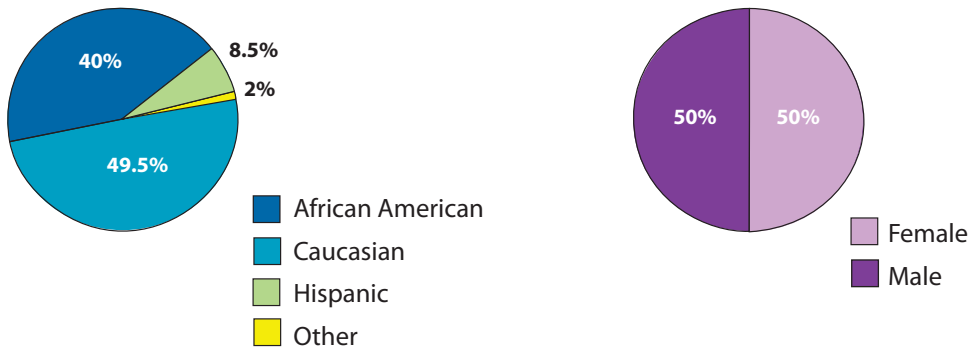
We served approximately 1,200 children and families—more than doubling the number served in less than 2 years.



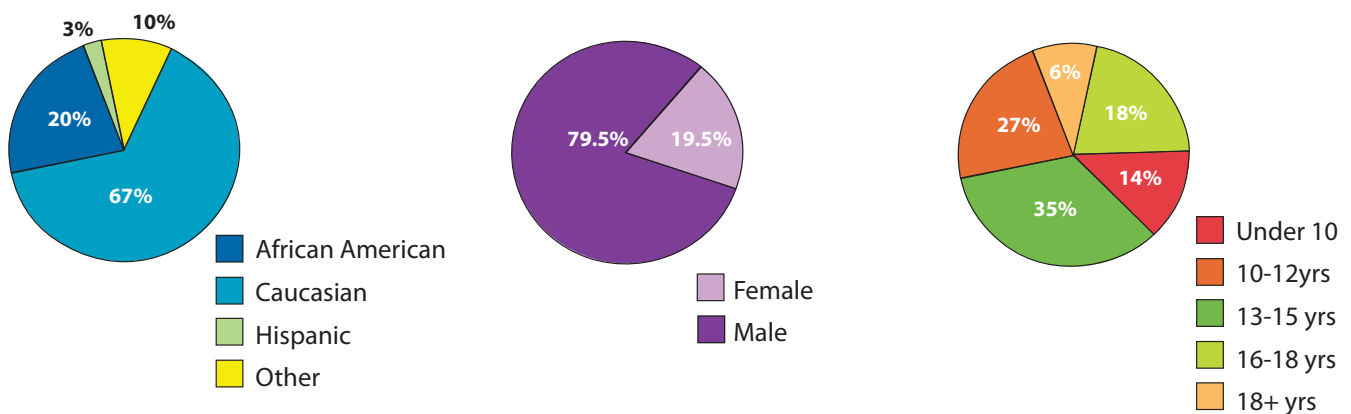
In NC last year, over 100,000 children who needed services like we provide did not receive them—8,000 of those children are right here in our local region.

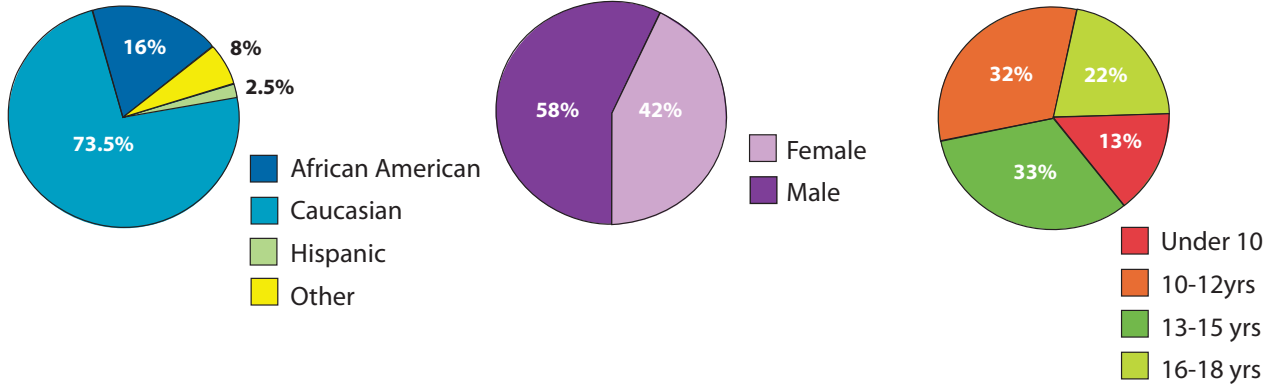
## Early Childhood Education: Race & Gender



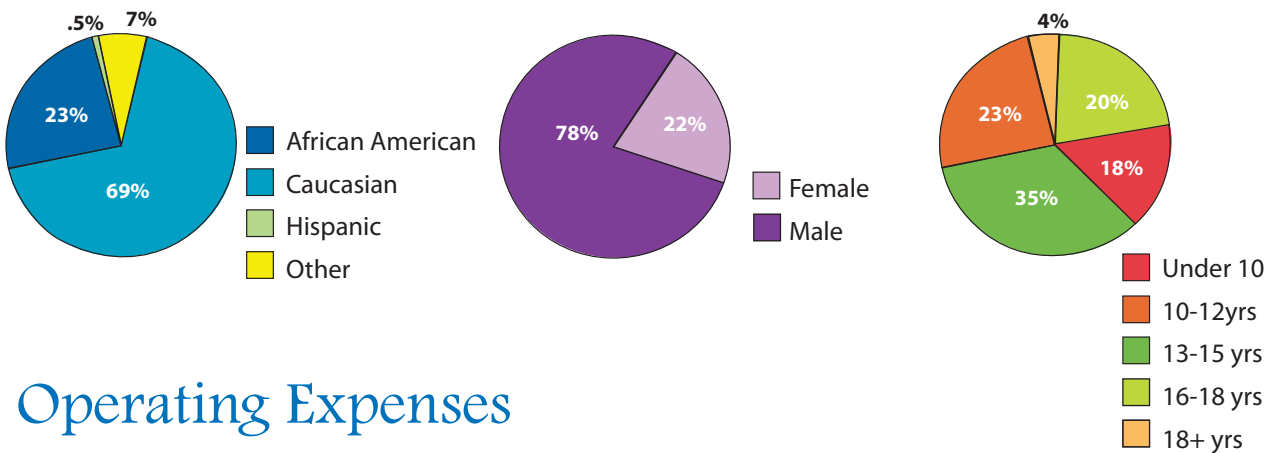
## Alternative Education: Race, Gender & Age



## Group Homes & Foster Care: Race, Gender & Age

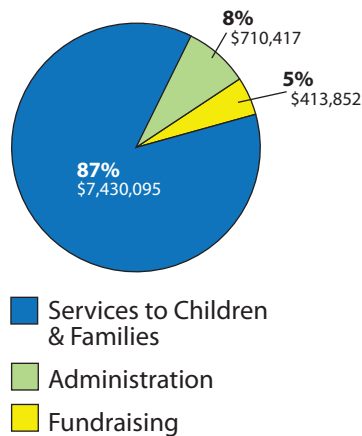


## Community-Based Services: Race, Gender & Age



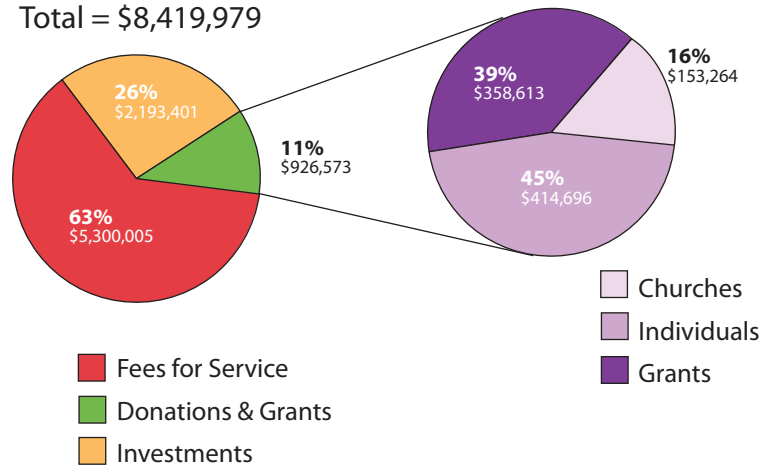
## Operating Expenses

## Operating Revenue

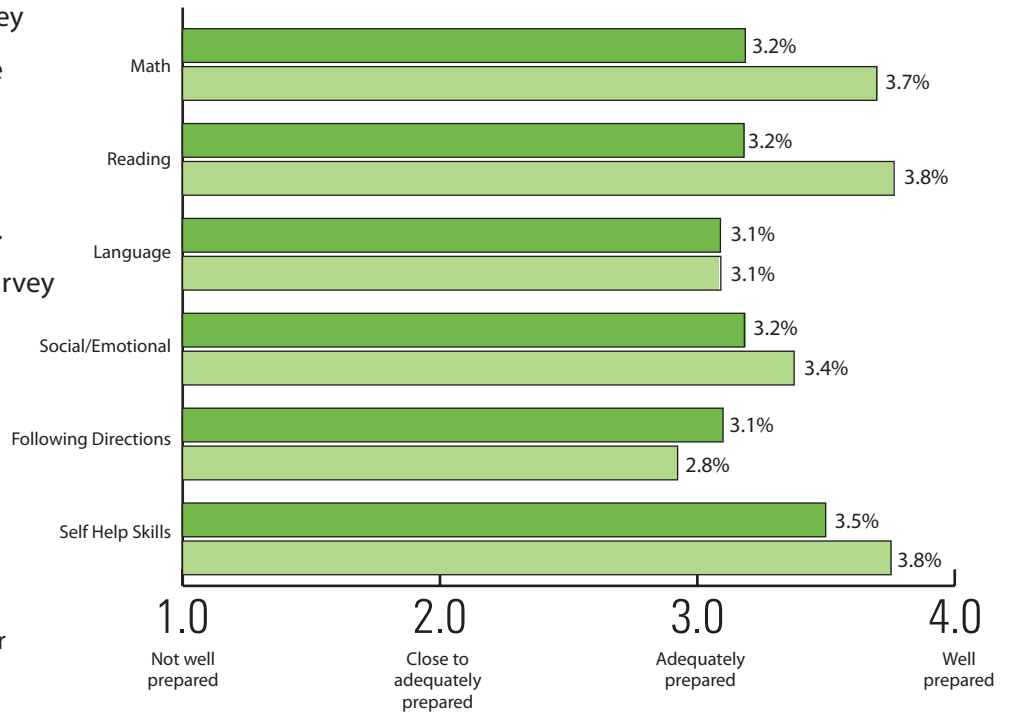

# Kindergarten Readiness Survey

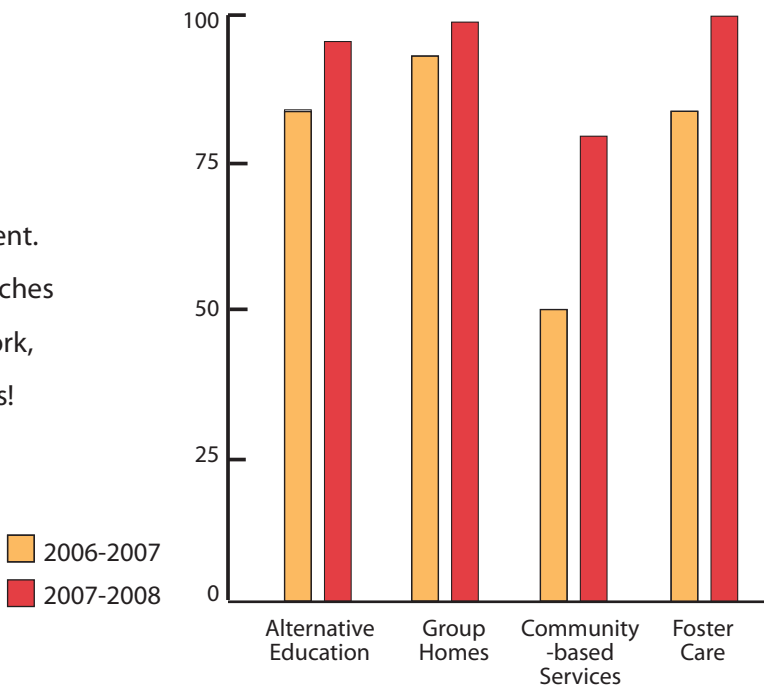
